The catalogue contains a CD-ROM (Windows 95 and higher) including an English section with a wealth of information: detailed product descriptions, video clips, photos with zoom feature, sounds, instructions, a dealer list, screen saver and much more!

## **System requirements:**

Windows 95 and higher, Hard Drive with a minimum of 60 MB of space available, minimum 32 MB RAM, 256 colors.

## **Starting:**

The CD-ROM starts automatically when inserted in a disk drive. No installation is required and no files will be copied on hard

disk until required for added functionality. In the event the autorun feature is not enabled on your computer, the disk may be started manually by clicking MDIPLUS.EXE in the root directory of the CD-ROM.

Initially, the German version of the CD will

be displayed on your monitor. Click on the US flag for the English version. On the screen you can see thumbnail pictures of all articles together with the item numbers.

With buttons at the top on the right side you can minimize the picture or close the program.




Table The »Table button shows all items in a list.

By clicking in the headlines of the list you can sort (e.g. by number, description, scale, etc.).

The »Detail« button shows more information of a marked item (you can also double click an item in the table or a small picture in the sum-


The »Info« button shows the dealer list, screen saver and other items. For these functions, Adobe Acrobat Reader must be installed. If Acrobat Reader is not already installed on your computer, an installation program will start automatically and install the English version of the Acrobat Reader 5.05.



The arrow symbols will allow you to browse through the catalogue and to jump to the first or last item.

The **binoculars** button calls up the search function to select special items. Example:

You want to search the catalogue for all H0 items for level (grade) crossings. Click the binocular button. A small "filter" screen is displayed. Under "Felder" (Field), click "scale" and select by double-clicking "H0." Then select "Type" and double-click "Warning lights for level crossings." Finally, click the "OK" button. In the table and in the summary only the H0 items for level crossings are displayed.



If you wish to see all items again, select the binocular button again, click "Aufheben" (Cancel) and the "OK" button.

ABC Detail Detail symbol: This function shows detailed information for a selected item. Clicking on the picture will allow you to zoom in.

With these function keys,

you can enlarge or reduce the pictures. The "screen" key shows the picture as large as possible. To come back to the detailed information, use the "left arrow" key —.

Camera symbol: If the item has an associated video or sound, this icon is shown. Clicking this symbol starts the animation.

»I« symbol: For many items we have supplied additional information, instructions, etc. This information is recalled by the "Information" key. Important: To display this information, Adobe Acrobat Reader must be installed on your computer.
